BIBLE STUDY QUESTIONS (WEDNESDAYS AT 7 PM)

1. Martin Luther feared a righteous God who is justly angry at sinners (Rom 1:18). How, then, can God's righteousness be "good news" (Rom 1:16-17)?
2. On what basis can a sinner be justified by God? (Rom 1:16-17; 3:28)
3. Many people think that good deeds will earn God's favour and acceptance. What does the Bible say about this?
4. Luther and the other reformers asserted that Scripture alone is our authority. What authorities do people in our society look to instead of Scripture?
5. Many people in Luther's day put their trust in the false hope that buying indulgences would forgive their sins. What false hopes are people in our society trusting in?
6. By the 16th Century the Roman Church had drifted into many theological errors. How can we guard Meadowlands against theological error?
7. Martin Luther and many others throughout church history have been willing to die for the truths of the Gospel. How do their examples encourage you to boldly stand for Christ?
