## BIBLE STUDY QUESTIONS (WEDNESDAYS AT 7 PM)

1. What evidence do you see in our society of prideful boasting?
2. Is there a kind of boasting that is good? (Jer 9:23-24; Gal 6:14; 2 Thes 1:3-4)
3. What does Acts 17:1-10 tell us about the situation in Thessalonica?
4. Why did Paul write a second letter to the Thessalonian church so soon after the first letter? What were his concerns?
5. Compare the first four verses of 1 Thessalonians with the first four verses of 2 Thessalonians. What are the similarities and differences?
6. Paul was thankful to God that their faith, love, and patience were progressing. Although these are evidences of God's working, what can we do to cultivate these virtues in our lives?
7. In 2 Thessalonians 1:3-4 Paul seems to encourage these people without engendering pride. How can you follow this example in your interactions with fellow believers?
