BIBLE STUDY QUESTIONS (WEDNESDAYS AT 7 PM)

1. Our society is characterized by vast information and knowledge, but are we any wiser than previous generations? In what ways is true wisdom lacking in our culture?
2. Compare God's wisdom with human wisdom. (Rom 1:18-23; 1 Cor 2:4-8; James 3:13-17)
3. What are the various groupings of the Old Testament books? Which ones are the "wisdom books"?
4. What does Proverbs 3:7-8 teach about health? What does Proverbs 8:17-21 teach about wealth?
5. How does the Book of Job inform our understanding of the Proverbs listed above?
6. What was wrong about the conclusion drawn by Job's friends? (Job 3-28)
7. How should we live in light of the messages of Job and Ecclesiastes? (Ecc 12:9-14)
