## BIBLE STUDY QUESTIONS (WEDNESDAY BIBLE STUDY)

1. What does Paul say about Christ's authority in Ephesians 1:20-22 & Colossians 1:15-18?
2. How would a biblical understanding of Christ's authority encourage believers living under ungodly leadership?
3. What is different about a person who lives each day submitting to Christ as the supreme authority?
4. Paul repeatedly states that Christ alone is the "head" of the church (Eph 1:22; 4:15; 5:23; Col 1:18; 2:19). What are some false substitutes that have led many churches astray?
5. As Head of the Church, Christ gives the body life. According to Ephesians 2:1-9, how is a dead sinner made alive?
6. As Head of the Church, Christ gives power to the body. What does Paul tell us about this power in Ephesians 1:19-23?
7. What should the members of the Meadowland family do to maintain Christ's power? How should we guard ourselves from losing His power?
